As a Little Magpies Coach, you will be responsible for planning and delivering a fun and inclusive session for young players in Reception and Year 1.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Coaching

- Ability to interact positively with the young players and firmly place importance on fun.
- Responsible for planning and delivering sessions to enable young players to learn basic football techniques.
- Embrace the Club's ethos by understanding that the session will include a variety of different abilities and remain inclusive at all times.

- Attend all in-service and coaching courses as directed by the Club, where possible.
- Work closely with the Foundation Phase Lead Coach to identify, and encourage, a pathway to U7 football for young players who start Year 2 at school.
- Multi-disciplinary communication between other Coaches, players and parents to ensure the well-being and development of all players is at the heart of everything you do.
- Maintain honesty and integrity at all times when working with young players at the Club.
- Be presentable, smart and personable at all times when representing the Club.
- Undertake all reasonable tasks assigned by the Club and Foundation Phase Lead Coach.
